## Incident Assessment

Unst WTW THM Failure 29 September 2010

## Summary of Incident

A series of treated water samples between July and November 2010 failed the regulatory 100ug/l limit for Trihalomethanes (THM). An incident was declared because water quality had not been restored to the required standard within two months.

## **DWQR** Assessment of Cause of Incident

There has been a history of THM issues at this water supply due to the simple treatment applied to the water. Scottish Water has a planned improvement project to upgrade the treatment at this works scheduled in the 2010/2015 timeframe.

## **DWQR** Assessment of Actions Taken by Scottish Water

DWQR will continue to monitor water quality at this supply and press for a timely implementation of the water treatment upgrade.
